Based on a recommendation in the Toronto Police Service's Transformational Task Force report Action Plan: The Way Forward to Modernize Community Safety in Toronto, 54 Division and 55 Division are being consolidated. The City of Toronto's Real Estate Services division, in partnership with the Toronto Police Service and City Planning, has conducted a search for suitable properties within the service areas of 54 Division and 55 Division. After evaluating properties through a set of criteria, a shortlist of three potential properties was created for a new Police Station.
